Oregon Tilth (OTCO), a respected name in organic certification, certifies the fabric and wool we use according to the Global Organic Textile Standard (GOTS). OMI's wool and cotton mattresses, pillows, and wool toppers also have been certified to the GOTS standard. The Global Organic Textile Standard (GOTS) was created to ensure that manufactured textiles — from raw-material sources through manufacturing practices all the way to the finished product — are processed and handled in such a way that organic integrity is maintained every step of the way. It assures that employees are paid and treated fairly and work in a safe, clean environment, and provides customers with credible assurance that organic integrity that is respected internationally.
